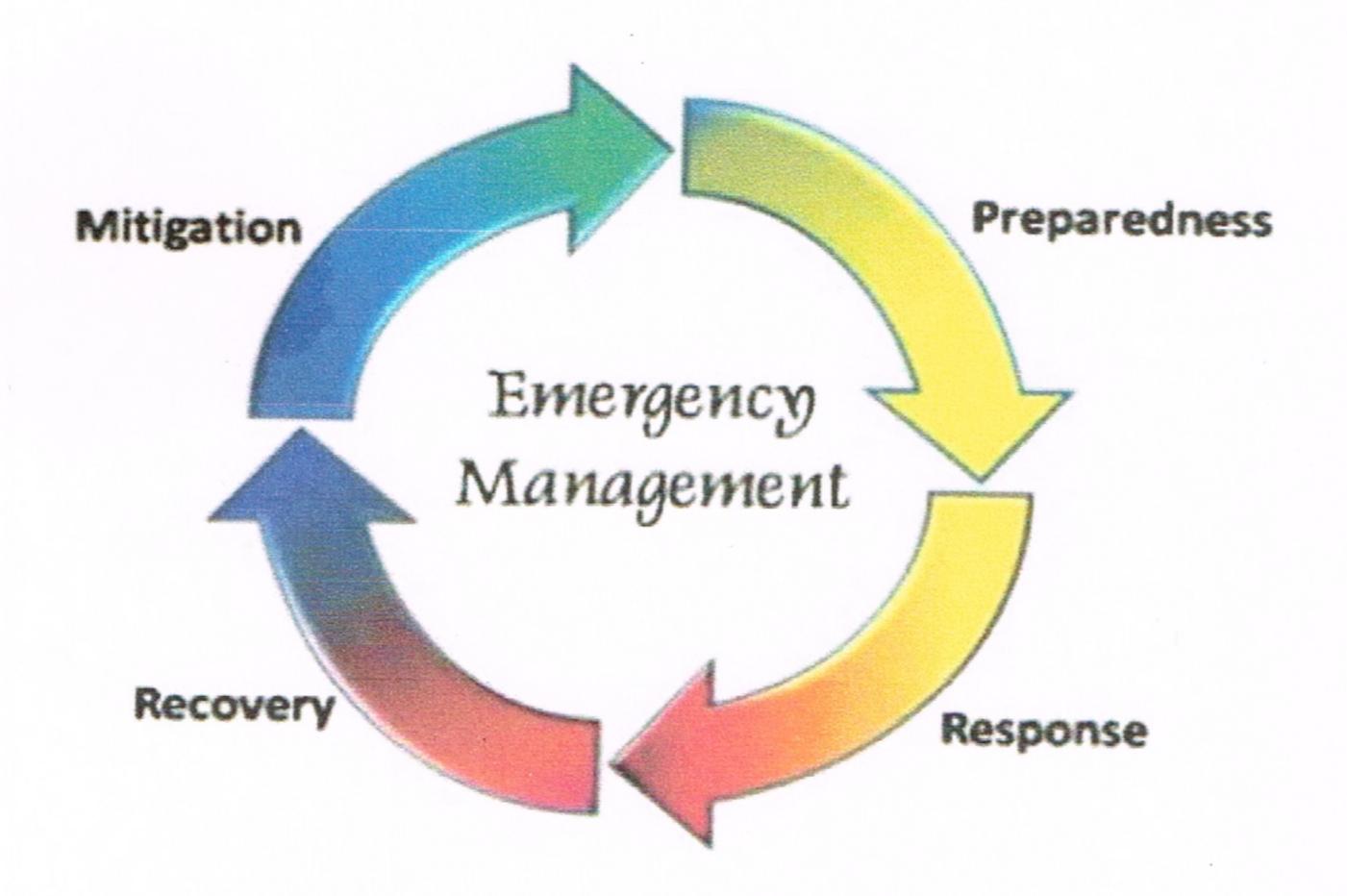

Executive Summary

Background

This Training Requirements document describes the Office of Information and Technology (OIT), Technology Training and Support Program (TTSP), Educational Technology Center's (ETC) understanding of the OIT Emergency Management Group's (EMG) request for training on Public Safety and Occupant Emergency Planning Employee Awareness and Response.

Training will be developed for all Department X (DEPTX) OIT government employees and contractors located in all Washington DC, Northern Virginia, and Maryland DEPTX/OIT facilities.
